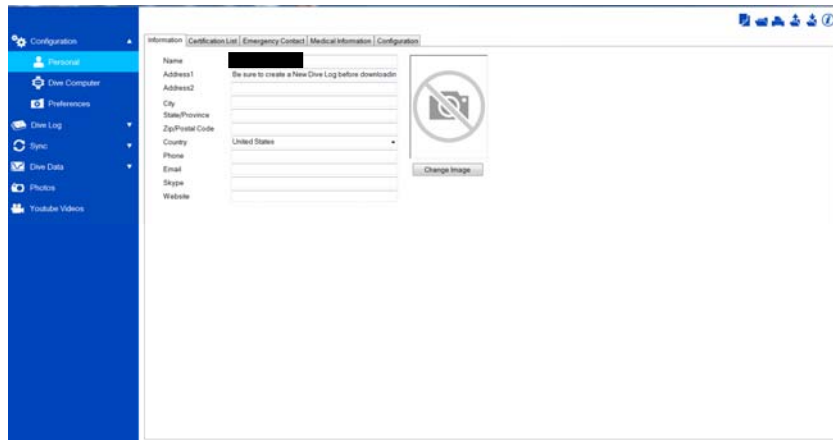


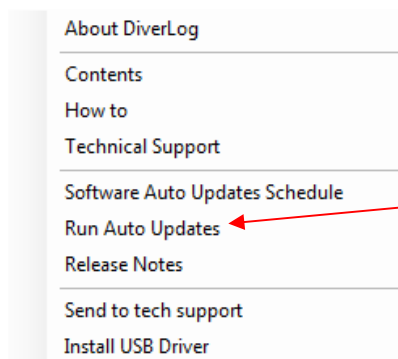
How to perform firmware updates using Diverlog

Confirm Diverlog is up to date

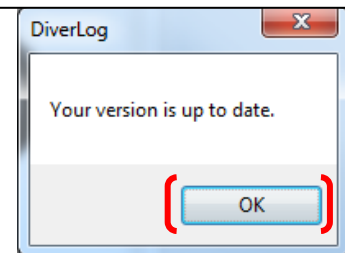


Click the “i” to open the help menu

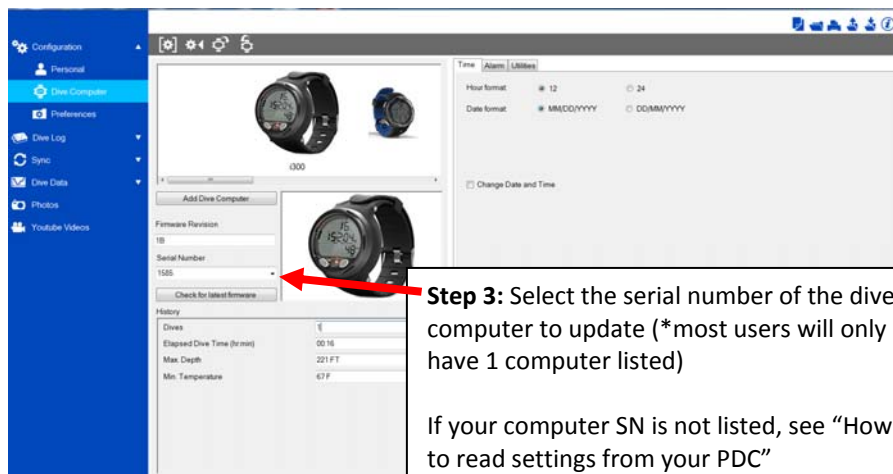
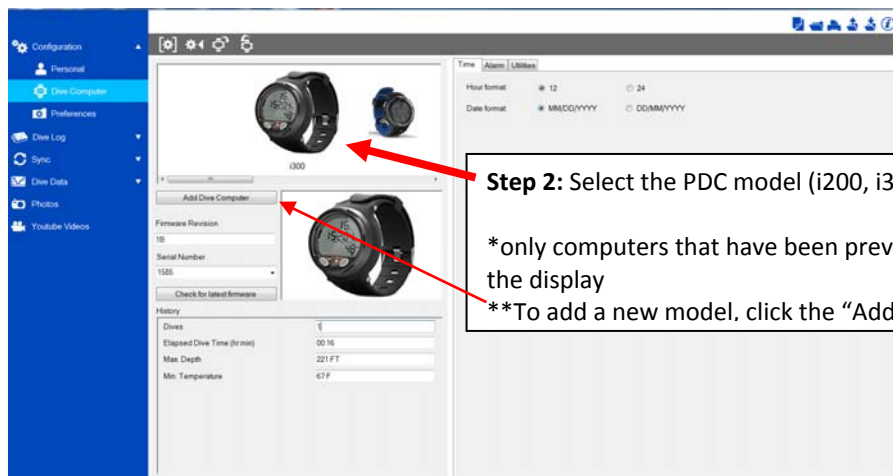
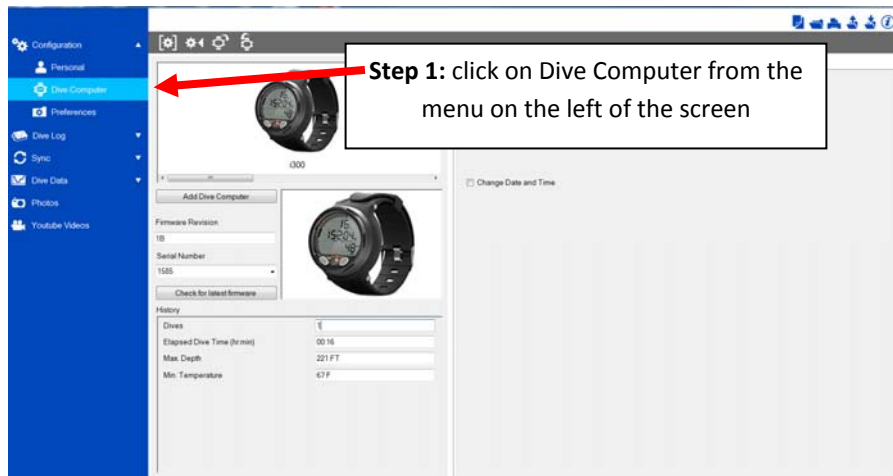


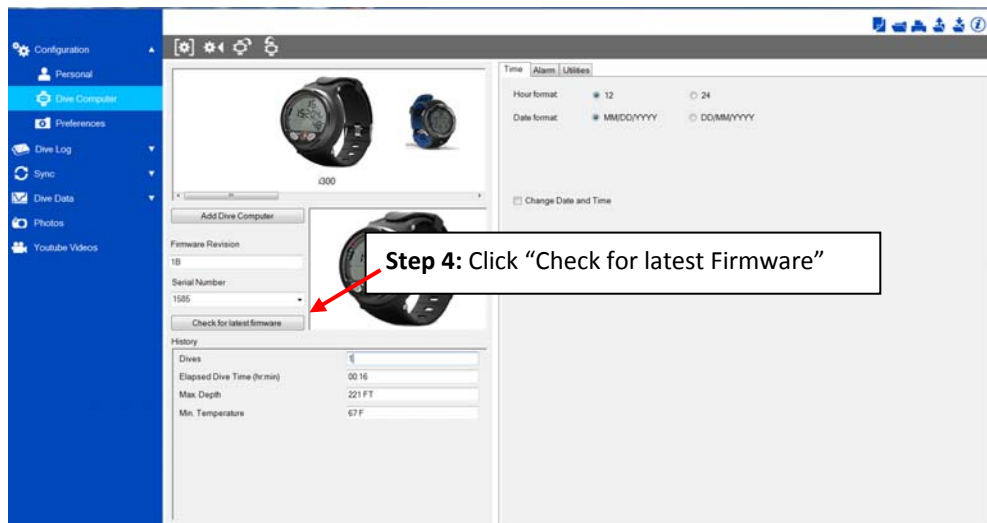
Click “Run Auto Updates”

Click “OK” if your version is up to date or run the updates if required

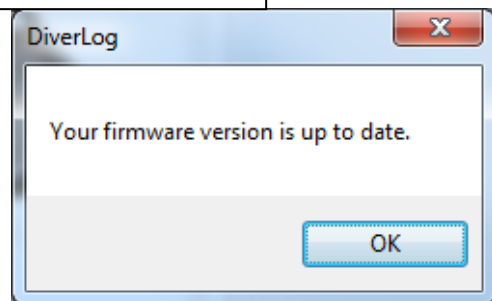
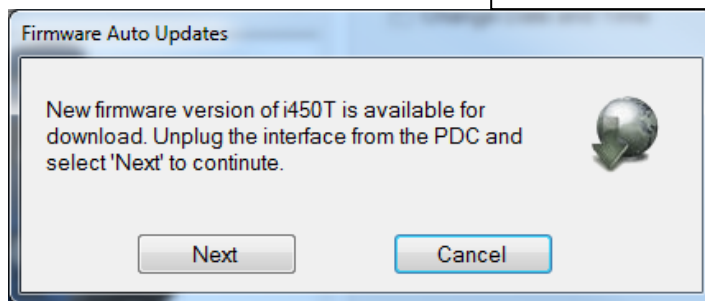
